1956 SERIES I LAND ROVER HIGHLY COLLECTABLE 107 INCH PICKUP

Built in 1956 as a CKD (Completely Knocked Down) kit by Brittain's Group on Dublin's Naas Road, this Land Rover served with the County Laois Fire Service.

Appliance No. 1 remains remarkably original and comes with original equipment including a bonnet-mounted hose frame, first aid hose with reel and tank, roof frame with ladder, two searchlights, Godiva Firefly pump, brass Auto Minimax extinguisher, spare hoses, horn, siren, and a spare pump. It still has its original 1997cc 4-cylinder engine with only 10,441 miles.

Also offered for sale separately, is a fully restored 1938 Beresford-Stork Light Pump Trailer with hoses and a companion vehicle from the Laois Fire Service - a 1956 Series I 109-inch Pickup RHD Export Appliance No. 5 formerly served at the Mountmellick station with County Laois Fire Services. The appliance was expertly restored by Pauric Cullen, former Station Officer in Longford town.

OVERVIEW

This Series I features a solid bulkhead and chassis, vibrant fire engine-red paintwork, and an aluminium body with only minor wear and a light patina. The canvas tilt and steel hood sticks remain in good condition.

The interior is well preserved, featuring three front red vinyl spade seats and two rear bench seats, all in very good condition. The dashboard and original gauges are clean, fully functional, and reflect the vehicle's care.

Appliance No. 1 is a rare CKD example and a notable piece of Irish Land Rover history. Maintained with care over the years, it shares a close association with the County Laois Fire Service. Last taxed in 2018, it was a regular and much-loved presence in St. Patrick's Day parades.

Also being offered is Appliance No. 5, from the Laois Fire Service - 1956 Series I 109-inch Pickup RHD Export. A restored 1938 Beresford-Stork Light Pump Trailer, complete with original hoses and also formerly of the Laois Fire Service.

These Land Rover fire tenders and the classic 'chariot-style' pump trailer offer collectors a rare and unmissable opportunity to own a matched set of historic Irish fire appliances.
