ALL ORIGINAL V8 ENGINE - ONE OWNER

The Series III 109-Inch was promoted as the ultimate Land Rover by offering seating for 9 passengers and effortless torque.

Fitted with an early 3.5L V8 Range Rover engine and a selectable centre diff lock, *many consider it the most capable Series Land Rover built in Solihull.*

The model took the name 'Stage I' from the government funding scheme that made its development possible.

Built in Australia, this 1982 Stage III V8 was imported into New Zealand as a CKD, and later purchased in an executor sale. Its highlight is a low-mileage, 3.5-litre V8 with 8:13:1 compression, two-speed transfer box permanent 4WD and locking central diff.

OVERVIEW

The 45-year-old bodywork is in excellent condition. Included with the vehicle are a brand-new spare wheel and a new rear door.

The bodywork and wheel rims are finished in Pageant Blue, a colour taken from the Triumph sports car range. Additional features include a ball and pin tow bar, two front bumper towing eyes and all original, fully functional lighting lenses. A lockable fuel cap and bonnet enhance security, along with a rear step for easier access at the back door.

The five-seat station wagon is equipped with rear bench seating and the full complement is present.

Acclaimed as the most capable Series Land Rover, this exceptional example features the revered 3.5L V8, known for its smooth power and strong torque. With permanent 4WD and solid bodywork, this Series III Stage I V8 stands out as a distinctive addition to any Land Rover collection.
